


THE ARTISTS

Using mainly acrylic on canvas <u>Nella</u> creates art to reflect her positive outlook on life, with an impetus to inspire others to experience the beauty in the world around them. Her love of bold colour excites and stimulates the viewer.



<u>Sue</u> is best known for her sports photography, which has been internationally published. In addition to capturing action Sue is drawn to documenting life through words and images. Her subject matter conjures emotion naturally and tells a story.
